Morning Camp (9am - 12 pm) – 1 tutor : 6 students Afternoon Camp (1pm - 4pm) – 1 tutor : 6 students Full Day Camp (9am - 4pm) – 1 tutor : 6 students

All camps include taking students to Field Park in Milton, ON which is a 7 minute walk from our tutoring centre at 9125 Derry Road, Milton, ON. Volunteers will also be on site to assist with Summer Camp ratios.

Emergency Contacts

We kindly request that every camper has two emergency contacts. Every participant must have an emergency contact in case the primary contact is unavailable. Please make sure the emergency contact information is complete and distinct from the primary contact information.

Attendance Communication

For all camps, please give us a call by 8:30 am at 647-888-0877, to notify us if your child won't be participating due to illness or for any other reason. In the event that your child cannot go to camp, please let us know. If at all possible, please call us or send us an email to admin@thetutorscholar.com so that we can prepare appropriately and let their tutor know not to anticipate them.

Feeling Unwell

A participant must be picked up within an hour of the parent or caregiver being notified if they start to feel sick or exhibit symptoms. If any participants are ill, we respectfully ask them not to attend camp until they are feeling better.



Pick Up and Drop Off

When a parent or guardian picks up a camper, they must present a picture ID. Staff can make sure that campers are only sent into the custody of their parent or guardian, or into the care of someone else chosen by them, thanks to photo IDs. If your child is unable to attend camp, kindly let the Administrative Assistants or Summer Camp Leader know ahead of time. If an expected participant does not show up, we will check-up with a phone call. When signing up on our website and before Summer Camp begins, please make sure your Tutor Scholar account contains the correct contact information. Please make sure that all information is current and that everyone identified as a chaperon is conscious of this necessity. Every day, children must be signed in and out by their authorized chaperon. Older children may sign themselves in and out of the camp with your consent.

Medication

In order for medication to be administered, we will only accept doctor-prescribed drugs. Our website has the Medication Authorization and Administration Form available for download. A completed Medication Authorization and Administration Form is required if your child needs medication during the camp. The name of the child, dosage requirement and administration directions must be clearly indicated on the original medication container. Every prescription must be signed by the parent or legal guardian authorizing the summer camp staff to administer the



medication. At the end of the day or week, if requested, the medication will be signed back into the custody of a parent or guardian and kept secure. Medication, such as asthma puffers and epipens, will be transported by the Summer Camp Tutor or, if specified by the parent or legal guardian on the Medication Authorization and Administration Form, by the camper. Although they won't give out medication, staff will watch over participants who can give it to themselves. Staff will help if the participant's condition becomes life-threatening and they are unable to give themselves medication, such as an epipen or asthma inhalers.

Expectations of Conduct

At Tutor Scholar, we promote a fun and engaging environment for students to learn. We believe that maintaining a positive space for students is what contributes to the joy of camp. We expect our summer campers to conduct themselves in ways that encourage positive experiences. If a child conducts themself in manners that are not conducive to our positive standard of politeness, equality and obedience, their parent or guardian will be notified. We ask that the parent or guardian discipline the child to correct the behaviour. A child may be removed from the program if misconduct continues and no refund will be issued.

In Case of Emergency

We make safety a priority at Tutor Scholar. All activities will be supervised by our Summer Crew and be conducted in a safe manner. We have a First Aid kit in our tutoring centre and it will be carried to the park for outdoor play. If a child gets a minor cut or scrape, our staff will clean the area and administer an adhesive bandage. In the highly unlikely event of an ambulance being required to carry your child to the hospital, one of our crew members will travel with them and you will be contacted promptly.

Camp Essentials Checklist

The following is a list of items that are required for camp on a daily basis:

- Sunscreen and hat
- Boots (on wet days)
- Running shoes and an extra pair
- Water bottle filled with water
- Healthy lunch and beverages
- Snacks

Please ensure that your child's name is labelled on all items. On hot days, please apply sunscreen on your child before your arrival at the centre.

Applying Sunscreen

At least 30 minutes before arriving at camp, please apply sunscreen on your child to protect them from ultra-violet (UV) rays. For older children, please see to it that your child can apply their own sunscreen. If your child needs help with applying sunscreen, our Summer Camp Crew will assist them. We will re-apply sunscreen after one and a half hours of your child's arrival if we are going outside again, so please bring sunscreen. Also, please make sure your child has a hat to further protect them.

Eating a Healthy Lunch Makes a Happy Bunch

We encourage you to pack a filled water bottle and healthy lunch for your child which contains a good daily nutritional value. Please ensure that your child also has adequate beverages and snacks for the length of the camp. In order to keep your child's food at an optimal temperature, we suggest packing an ice pack in your child's lunch bag.





Food Allergies

At Tutor Scholar, we operate a nut-free Summer Camp Program. No nuts of any kind or foods containing nut by-products are permitted in the tutoring centre.

Please do not pack nuts of any kind in your child's lunch including peanut butter, tree nuts, nut butters, nut containing granola bars etc.
